Italy is delighted to have won the FIP XIII European Championship in Sotogrande and proud to welcome to Milan Polo Ladies playing for Great Britain, Ireland, Gemany and Italy.

These are the nations competing in the third edition of the `U.S. Polo Assn. – III FIP Ladies European Championship 2021' hosted from September 21st to 26th at the beautifully organised Polo Club La Mimosa in Pogliano Milanese, a very British styled corner of Italy just a few minutes from the centre of Milan.





Increasingly tougher Ladies in the world of polo

Like all equestrian disciplines, be they included in the Olympic Games or not, Polo is a sport in which **men** and women compete together.

It is true that in the equestrian world gender equality is very well known but polo, the **most ancient** of equestrian sports, was the last to acknowledge the arrival of ladies in a sporting context since it was quite unusual to see women playing top level polo until about two decades ago, while ladies were already winning gold medals in Olympic disciplines such as show jumping, eventing and dressage as well as in World Championships.

For some years now, however, **ladies polo** has started to catch up quickly and the number of players is **constantly increasing**. Tournaments reserved to ladies, which initially seemed to be something really new, have now multiplied and the calendar is intense and exciting in many countries. The International Polo Federation (FIP) created the European Championships in 2017 and Argentina too has launched a ladies' version of the most important tournaments in the world, the Camera, Republica and Abierto.

The club has an active polo school run by a qualified instructor so as to start the young off in this wonderful sport, all thanks to the passion experienced by its president Stefania Annunziata, daughter of the immensely famous polo player Horacio Annunziata, a legend and a pioneer for polo in Italy.
